Preface

The purpose of this document is to bring together information relating to the Bagwell surname, occurring on the Isle of Wight and elsewhere in Hampshire prior to 1900, which are not related to myself. In achieving this objective it also illustrates the ancestry of spouses marrying into those Bagwell families.

This narrative is produced in two formats, private and public.

The Public Edit has been separated into four sections. See “Using the Narratives” below for more information. Only basic information is provided within the public edit in order to identify individuals and key life events, typically: birth, baptism, marriage, death, burial and occasional observations regarding the same. In this way each narrative should provide signposting for fellow researchers, without detracting from the joy of discovering their ancestors for themselves.

Private edits are restricted to close family and selected researchers, and contain substantially more detailed information.

Using the Narratives

Each narrative is a live document, with periodic updates being made to individual generations and family groups. As a consequence the reader might find some inconsistencies between linked family trees. You should refer to page 1 of this narrative for the edition date, and individual generation or family groups for revision dates. Please delete or destroy all previous editions of this narrative as they are now outdated and may contain errors and inconsistencies.

Narratives are organised into four parts:

- Part 1 illustrates Bagwell families on the Isle of Wight;
- Part 2 lists other families associated by marriage;
- Part 3 illustrates other Bagwell families connected with Portsmouth and its surrounding area; and
- Part 4 lists other families associated with those families detailed in Part 3.

Navigation through this document can be achieved through the use of the table of contents and embedded bookmarks for each of the four parts. You can also use the find (Ctrl + F keys) to search for specific information.

Whilst every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of this document, it can not be guaranteed error free. To submit any corrections, or indeed share additional information about a common ancestor, please use the Bagwell Genealogy contact me page.

Family Identification

Inter-familial relationships are one area of interest to me, as part of my wider research. Each family within my research has been assigned an alpha-numeric number for ease of identification, and searching within the narrative documents. I have attempted to restrict the mapping of all families to a basic structure.

Each individual has an allocated Unique Reference Number (URN) and, whilst these are not usually referred to within any published documents outside of my database, they do form the basis of further family identification.

Every individual or direct family unit (parents and siblings) where known, are identified by a Family Group (FG) reference. Where two or more family units are known they are collectively given a Family Identifier (FID).

Although the family group may be referred to within the narrative, the absence of any further information indicates that I currently have no information to publish. Spousal surnames in brackets indicate those persons for whom I have not yet identified their pre-marital names. In these instances a family number has not been allocated. For reasons unknown to myself at this present time, it is inadvisable to attempt a web site search for a family reference alone, as most search engines fail to produce satisfactory search results. The reader will find further information regarding family identification within the Surname Index available on my web site.

1.1 John Bagwell, died 1779 and Sarah Bagwell, died 1759

I have published information regarding John on the Wight Narrative together with that information for Sarah Bagwell as, whilst I only have burial records for both at present, it is my belief that they were in fact man and wife. Mary and Jane Bagwell (parts 1.2 and 1.3) and Robert Bagwell (part 1.4) are potentially the children of John and Sarah. Further information regarding this assumption can be found in "Origins Of The Bagwell Families Of The Isle Of Wight".

BAZ0794 (Last updated 30/11/2016)

John BAGWELL was born before 1779. He died in 1779 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. He was buried on 24 Feb 1779 in All Saints, Calbourne, Isle of Wight.

Sarah BAGWELL was born before 1759. She died in 1759 in Yarmouth, Isle of Wight. She was buried on 1 Jun 1759 in St James' Church, Yarmouth, Isle of Wight.

1.2 Mary Bagwell ca.1735-1775 m. Richard Coleman

I am currently unable to identify the ancestors of Mary or any other record of her on the Isle. It is possible that she is the daughter of John and Sarah Bagwell - See Part 1.1. Alternatively, although I know of no direct family links, she is contemporary with the daughter of Charles and Elizabeth Bagwell of Portsmouth - See Part 3.1

BAZ0438 (Last updated 30/11/2016)

Mary BAGWELL was born before 1735. She died after 1775.

Mary BAGWELL and Richard COLEMAN were married on 5 Nov 1753 in Brook, Isle of Wight. **Richard COLEMAN**, son of John COLEMAN and Ann (COLEMAN), was born in 1738 in St Lawrence, Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 10 Apr 1738 in St Lawrence, Isle of Wight. Richard died after 1775. *FG BAZ439*

1.3 Jane Bagwell ca.1730-1762 m. John Nicholas

I am currently unable to identify the ancestors of Jane. There are no other records relating to her on the Isle. It is possible that she is the daughter of John and Sarah Bagwell - See Part 1.1

BAZ0801 (Last updated 30/11/2016)

Jane BAGWELL was born before 1730. She lived in Shalfleet, Isle of Wight in 1747. She died after 1762.

Jane BAGWELL and John NICHOLAS were married on 28 Feb 1747 in Shalfleet, Isle of Wight. **John NICHOLAS** was born before 1730. He died after 1762. *FG BAZ802*

1.4 Bagwell Family (IOW Godshill 1700-1900)

Family ID #0201BAZ

1.41 Robert Bagwell ca.1733-1816 m. Sarah Lake

I am currently unable to identify the ancestors of Robert. It is possible that he is the son of John and Sarah Bagwell - See Part 1.1

Family Group BAZ0201 (Last updated 26/05/2017)

Robert BAGWELL was born about 1733. Robert died on 13 Nov 1816 in Bridge, Godshill, Isle of Wight. He was buried on 15 Nov 1816 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight.

Robert BAGWELL and Sarah LAKE were married on 21 Mar 1763 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. Sarah LAKE or LEAKE **Sarah LAKE**, daughter of John LAKE, was born about 1741 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died on 3 Aug 1794 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. 03/08/1794 She was buried on 6 Aug 1794 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight. **FG BAZ202**

Robert BAGWELL and Sarah LAKE had the following children:

A. **John BAGWELL** was born in 1763 in Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 5 Jun 1763 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. He was buried on 10 May 1833 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight.

B. **Mary BAGWELL** was born about 1764 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 14 Oct 1784 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died in Jan 1802 in Brighstone, Isle of Wight. Mary was buried on 2 Jan 1802 at St Mary's Church in Brighstone, Isle of Wight.

Mary BAGWELL and James KING were in a relationship or partnership living as man and wife but not married about 1787 **James KING** was born before 1770. He died after 1787. **FG BAZ0217 [FID #0217BAZ] See Part 2**

Mary BAGWELL and William GOULD were married on 17 Dec 1789 in Shalfleet, Isle of Wight. **William GOULD**, son of William GOULD and Jane WHITEWOOD, was born about 1769 in Mottistone, Isle of Wight. He died in Feb 1801 in Brighstone, Isle of Wight. He was buried on 18 Feb 1801 at St Peter's & St Paul's Church in Mottistone, Isle of Wight. **FG BAZ0219 [FID #0219BAZ] See Part 2**

C. **Sarah BAGWELL** was born about 1766 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 2 Feb 1766 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died in Sep 1830 in Newchurch, Isle of Wight. She was buried on 3 Sep 1830 at All Saints' Church in Newchurch, Isle of Wight.

Sarah BAGWELL and Hugh THOMPSON were married on 18 Sep 1786 in Shalfleet, Isle of Wight. **Hugh THOMPSON**, son of James THOMPSON and Elizabeth VEASEY, was born in 1766 in Freshwater, Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 9 Mar 1766 in Freshwater, Isle of Wight. He died in Nov 1827 in Newchurch, Isle of Wight. He was buried on 9 Nov 1827 at All Saints' Church in Newchurch, Isle of Wight. **FG BAZ0229 [FID #0229BAZ] See Part 2.**

D. **Elizabeth BAGWELL** was born in 1767 in Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 20 Dec 1767 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died in 1768 in Isle of Wight. Elizabeth was buried on 23 Jan 1768 at All Saints' Church in Calbourne, Isle of Wight.

E. **Martha BAGWELL** was born in 1769 in Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 5 Feb 1769 in

Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died after 1794.

Martha BAGWELL and James DAY were married on 8 Jul 1793 at St Mary's Church in Portsmouth, Hampshire. **James DAY** was born before 1775. He died after 1794. *FG BAZ0236*

F. **Elizabeth BAGWELL** was born about 1770 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 4 Nov 1770 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died in Aug 1826 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. She was buried on 13 Aug 1826 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight.

Elizabeth BAGWELL and Thomas BRYANT were married on 13 Jul 1801 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. **Thomas BRYANT**, son of John BRYANT and Mary LONG, was born about 1772 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 13 May 1772 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. He died in Mar 1840 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. Thomas was buried on 19 Mar 1840 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight. *FG BAZ0238 [FID #0238BAZ] See Part 2*

G. **Jane BAGWELL** was born about 1772 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 13 Dec 1772 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died in Feb 1840 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. She was buried on 13 Feb 1840 at St George's Church in Arreton, Isle of Wight.

Jane BAGWELL and William WALLBRIDGE were married on 17 Jan 1794 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. **William WALLBRIDGE**, son of Joseph WALLBRIDGE and Elizabeth YELF, was born in 1769 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. He died on 23 Feb 1835 in Isle of Wight. He was buried on 2 Mar 1835 at St George's Church in Arreton, Isle of Wight. *FG BAZ0248 [FID #0248BAZ] See Part 2*

H. **Ann BAGWELL** was born in 1774 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 1 Aug 1774 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died in 1792 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. Ann was buried on 15 Apr 1792 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight.

I. **Hannah BAGWELL** was born in 1775 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 31 Dec 1775 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She died on 8 Jul 1853 in Newport, Isle of Wight. Hannah was buried on 14 Jul 1853 at St Mary's Church in Carisbrooke, Isle of Wight.

Hannah BAGWELL and James BARNES were married on 9 Apr 1800 at St Thomas á Becket Church in Portsmouth, Hampshire. **James BARNES**, son of John BARNES and Jane NORRIS, was born about 1772 in Freshwater, Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 20 Jan 1772 in Freshwater, Isle of Wight. He died on 14 Apr 1855 in Newport, Isle of Wight. James was buried on 18 Apr 1855 at St Mary's Church in Carisbrooke, Isle of Wight. *FG BAZ0254 [FID #0254BAZ] See Part 2*

J. **Robert BAGWELL** was born in 1777 in Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 4 May 1777 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. Robert died in Dec 1843 in New Village, Carisbrooke, Isle of Wight. He was buried on 29 Dec 1843 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight. *FG BAZ0213*

Robert BAGWELL and Mary GILBERT were married on 9 Oct 1810 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. **Mary GILBERT** was born about 1779 in Whippingham, Isle of Wight. She died in Sep 1835 in Northwood, Isle of Wight. Mary was buried on 14 Sep 1835 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight. *FG BAZ0265*

K. **Frances BAGWELL** was born in 1779 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 11 Apr 1779 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She was buried on 11 Mar 1827 in Arreton, Isle of Wight.

Frances BAGWELL and Nicholas SMITH were married on 2 Apr 1801 in Whippingham, Isle of Wight. **Nicholas SMITH**, son of Nicholas SMITH and Martha POPE, was born in 1777 at Woodhouse Farm in Whippingham, Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 22 Jul 1777 in Newchurch, Isle of Wight. Nicholas died in Aug 1833 in Shide, Isle of Wight. *FG BAZ0269 [FID #0269BAZ] See Part 2*

L. **Charlotte BAGWELL** was born in 1780 in Isle of Wight. She died in 1782 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. She was buried on 18 Apr 1782 at All Saints' Church in Calbourne, Isle of Wight.

M. **Rebecca BAGWELL** was born in 1785 in Isle of Wight. She died in 1837 in Newchurch, Isle of Wight. 24/04/1833

Rebecca BAGWELL and Henry LOE were married on 26 Sep 1805 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. Rebecca, a minor, married with consent **Henry LOE**, son of Henry LOE and Hannah HARVEY, was born about 1771 in Newchurch, Isle of Wight. In 1805 he was a Yeoman. He died in 1838 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. **FG BAZ0284 [FID #0284BAZ] See Part 2**

1.42 Robert Bagwell ca.1777-1843 m. Mary Gilbert

Son of Robert Bagwell and Sarah Lake (FG BAZ0201)

Family Group BAZ0213 (Last updated 30/11/2016)

Robert BAGWELL was born in 1777 in Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 4 May 1777 in Calbourne, Isle of Wight. Robert died in Dec 1843 in New Village, Carisbrooke, Isle of Wight. He was buried on 29 Dec 1843 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight. **FG BAZ213**

Robert BAGWELL and Mary GILBERT were married on 9 Oct 1810 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. **Mary GILBERT** was born about 1779 in Whippingham, Isle of Wight. She died in Sep 1835 in Northwood, Isle of Wight. Mary was buried on 14 Sep 1835 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight. **FG BAZ265**

Robert BAGWELL and Mary GILBERT had the following children:

A. **Sarah BAGWELL** was born on 2 Sep 1811 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 1 Oct 1811 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. She died in Aug 1866 in Newport, Isle of Wight. She was buried on 24 Aug 1866 at St Mary's Church in Carisbrooke, Isle of Wight.

B. **Charlotte BAGWELL** was born on 12 Sep 1812 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. She was baptized on 11 Oct 1812 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. She died on 22 Aug 1881 in Godshill, Isle of Wight. Charlotte was buried on 25 Aug 1881 at All Saints Church in Godshill, Isle of Wight.

C. **Robert BAGWELL** was born on 24 Jan 1815 in Pereton, Isle of Wight. He was baptized on 25 Jan 1815 in Arreton, Isle of Wight. He died in Dec Q 1886 in Newport, Isle of Wight.

1.6 William Bagwell ca.1752-1824

The record for this person comes from a transcript of the Gatcombe Parish Burial Register. I have no other record of this individual and the information does not relate to any other Bagwell living on the Isle.

BAZ0796 (Last updated 30/11/2016)

William BAGWELL was born about 1752. He died in 1824 in Gatcombe, Isle of Wight. He was buried on 30 May 1824 at St Olave's Church in Gatcombe, Isle of Wight.
